## **PANGELINAN SENDS LETTER TO DPW TO INCLUDE PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE LANES**

**FOR IMMEDIATE NEWS RELEASE (August 18, 2010 – Hagåtña) –**  
Senator ben c. pangelinan (D), Barrigada, Chairman of the Committee on Appropriations, Taxation, Banking, Retirement, Insurance, and Land sent a letter to the Department of Public Works to request they comply with Public Law 29-98 which mandates the incorporation of pedestrian and bicycle lanes in the construction of roadways.

“I introduced legislation two years ago, which is now Public Law 29-98 which enhances the safety of pedestrians and bicyclists on our roadways, by providing space for them on our roads. We have seen too many fatal pedestrian accidents and I believe that incorporating pedestrian and bicycle lanes will greatly reduce those incidents”, said Senator pangelinan.

With the many road projects the Department of Public Works is currently undergoing, it is important to comply with Public Law 29-98.
